We are currently seeking a self-motivated, pre-licensed or licensed clinician to join our team! We are accepting applications from LMFT's, LPC's, LCSW's, MFT-C's as well as LPCC's for a part-time or full-time position working with individuals, couples, and families across Colorado. This position will be either hybrid (part-time in person, part-time virtual) or 100% in person.

About Compass Healing Project: Compass Healing Project provides therapeutic services to individuals, couples and families across the state of Colorado and California (Licensed clinicians need only apply—virtual only). We specialize in working with adults and couples from a somatic therapy approach on all things trauma, attachment, whole-self (heart, mind, body, and soul) intersections with full spectrum intersections with sexuality, spirituality, and inclusivity. Our therapists are trained in a variety of therapeutic techniques; however, we specialize in Somatic Experiencing (SE), Somatic healing models, Psychobiological Approach to Couples Therapy (PACT), Internal Family Systems Therapy (IFS), Eye Movement Desensitization & Reprocessing (EMDR) and use an attachment lens for much of our clinical work.

Compass Healing Project was created by Marriage and Family Therapist and whole-maker, Natalie Cooney, who has been practicing therapy for almost a decade and all things healing for two. She specializes in trauma and whole-self integration, ancient, and contemporary healing processes and seeks to hire team members who are dedicated to wholeness and high quality healing processes. Compass Healing Project is dedicated to creating a safe place for healing and providing support for people who want to heal and are open to a somatic approach. We are looking to add team members who are looking to do meaningful work with their clients, collaborate with other like-minded professionals, and maintain a healthy work/life balance.

Minimum Qualifications:

- Master's Degree in Human Development & Family Studies, Counseling, Psychology, Social Work, Transpersonal Psychology, Counseling, Mental Health Counseling, and/or Marriage and Family Therapy.
- Experience working with individuals, couples, and educated and allied with all forms of relationship, sexuality, and gender expression and experience Alt+/Poly, the LGBTQ+ community.
- Registered with the state of Colorado as a Marriage and Family Therapist Candidate, Licensed Professional Counselor Candidate, Licensed Social Worker, Licensed Social Worker Candidate, Licensed Marriage and Family Therapist, or Licensed Professional Counselor OR Licensed in the State of California as an LMFT, LCSW, or LPCC.
- Able to maintain liability insurance for their clinical work.

Job Duties:

- Conduct psychotherapy sessions with individuals, couples & families. Part-time clinical expectations are 8-12 client hours per week and full-time clinical expectations are 15-22 clients per week.
- Maintain client correspondence, scheduling, and case management for all clinical cases. Case management includes timely completion of case notes, treatment plans, termination summaries, and any additional documentation needed for individual cases.
- Maintain professional, ethical, and legal standards set out by AAMFT and the State of Colorado.
- Attend regular supervision as-needed for licensure (weekly, bi-weekly, or monthly).
- Keep up with regular email and attend Compass Healing Project team meetings as necessary.
- Optional: Lead couples workshops on an as-needed/desired basis.

Compensation:

Licensed clinicians: 75/25 split of hourly rate per client hour worked. Subcontract with Medicaid and/or insurance optional (CO only). Bonus opportunities and compensation available for leading couples or specialized workshops.

Unlicensed clinicians: \$40 - \$60 per client hour depending on your chosen hourly rate. 60/40 split of your hourly rate. Subcontract with Medicaid and/or insurance optional. Bonus opportunities and compensation available for leading couples or specialized workshops.

Stipends offered to help cover health insurance costs and/or continuing education costs.
